Barbara Haering supports public and private institutions as an independent expert and consultant, specializing in applied research, strategy development and evaluation – mainly in the fields of science and innovation, public sector reform and sustainable development. She teaches public management at the University of Lausanne.

Barbara Haering studied environmental sciences at the ETH in Zurich and completed her studies with a Doctorate in participatory processes in urban planning. She has honorary doctorate of the University of Lausanne.

Barbara Haering chairs the Board of Foundation of the Geneva International Center for Humanitarian Demining GICHD as well as the Strategic Advisory Board of the University of Geneva and Vice-President of the Board of the Federal Institutes of Technology. She serves as a member of the Board of the TU Dresden, the Research and Innovation Board of the TU Graz and the national expert group on natural hazards PLANAT. In spring 2022 she has been appointed as a Commissioner for the International Commission on Missing people ICMP.

Barbara Haering has been a long-standing member of the Swiss Parliament, chairing the Committee on Science, Education and Culture as well as the Security Committee and serving as Vice-President to the Parliamentary Assembly of the OSCE. As Vice-President of the OSCE PA she chaired and participated in many election observation missions.
